4-H'er of the Year – Senior members with at least one year left in their 4-H career may apply for this \$600 scholarship and plaque (scholarship is to be used for higher education at a school of choice, and will be paid directly to the school Registrar). Final selection for the award is based on a personal interview with a panel of judges. Applicants must show overall outstanding club and county 4-H work in areas of leadership, personal growth, community service, community involvement, Fair accomplishments/achievements. Winner will reign for one year and promote 4-H in parades and public appearances. With their Record Book, applicants are required to submit a 500 word essay on “4-H” and 4-5 recommendations from 4-H Leaders (preferably at least one other than their own club leader), teachers, employers, etc.
